CSR projects Undertaken During the Financial Year 2022-23

SBI Gram Seva Project



SBI Payments has partnered with SBI Foundation for SBI Gram Seva project by sanctioning an amount of INR 1,02,81,051. SBI Gram Seva is an integrated rural development programme which aims at the socio-economic upliftment of rural India by adopting villages and working for their development. Through this project, we have sponsored the development projects in five villages in the district of Palghar, Maharashtra: Dolhari Kh, Satkor, Anandpur, Devpur, and Ghatalpada. It is an ongoing project for three years and the activities are implemented under Sri Chaitanya Seva Trust's Govardhan Rural Development Programme.

Through the project, we could make interventions on various fronts such as digitilisation, education, health and Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WaSH). Gram Seva Kendras are established in all the five villages with digital services. The Prerana Centre for Women operates within the Gram Seva Kendra in Dolhari Kh, aiming to empower women and promote gender equality. The centre has established sewing machines to deliver essential training to village women, enabling them to achieve self-sufficiency. Smart classrooms with instructional materials and computer labs are furnished for the children. Numerous endeavours, including activities like seed distribution and the implementation of mechanized farming, are undertaken to enhance livelihoods.









In all the five villages, health camps are being conducted once in every month and door-step medical services are provided by SBI Sanjeevani vehicle. UV Water filter plants and solar street- lights are installed in the villages. As a step towards increasing the ground water level and improving the access to irrigation facilities, 28 small wells are dug in identified locations in the five villages. Additionally, the project strives to raise community awareness regarding diverse government initiatives and other crucial information.

SBI Payments believes that everyone in the country should be able to access and afford quality health care. The contribution to the sector of healthcare is made with that goal in mind. Each year, lakhs of cases of cancer are reported in our country, making it one of the most serious health issues.
