Our Company has partnered with Shiksha Seva Foundation's Hindcare Polyclinic & Diagnostic Centre under the Swasth Bharat Program. The project involves upgradation of the Centre with essential medical and diagnostic equipment, with a focus on diagnostic services and ophthalmology. A key addition under the project is an advanced ultrasound machine, enhancing the Centre's ability to perform non-invasive imaging for early and accurate diagnosis of conditions such as abdominal, gynaecological, and cardiovascular issues. To maximize the impact, radiology technicians receive comprehensive training in both machine operation and diagnostic interpretation, ensuring high-quality care and better health outcomes for the local population.

The Company in collaboration with Spherule Foundation through its project Reviving Livelihood is committed to empower 100 women by providing essential business support that enables them to achieve financial independence and stability. Many of these women face obstacles such as financial constraints, lack of proper equipment, or inadequate working spaces. 
Project SBI Sanjeevani - Clinic on Wheels with SBI Foundation





The Company partnered with SBI Foundation to provide primary healthcare services at the doorsteps of villagers through Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) to reach inaccessible areas. The Mobile Medical Van is equipped with all basic medical equipment, medicines & a team of health practitioners consisting of a Doctor, Lab Technician and Pharmacist who reach at the selected villages on a routine basis to provide OPD services like consultation, prescription of medicines and facility for Lab tests by using semi-auto analyser equipment. Medical health camps as per the disease prevalence report from the MOPD/medical profiling in the locality with the help of specialist doctors like gynaecologists, orthopaedic, dentists, and general medicine along with special camps for pregnant women and infants were also be organised.
